* Around the table:

- **Is there a plan for students eating lunch? (10 min on, 10 min off)** Staff will revisit this and come up with a solution for students in junior grades. There will also be procedures for students to use lockers for winter gear.
- Are there tables that fold down in the gym? Yes, but the gym is being used for storage and staff lunchroom. Public health wants to limit crossover between different groups so the gym is not an option.
- **Are there any clubs running this year other than student council?** No, because we can't have students gathering outside their class groups.
- **Is it normal to have so many supply teachers**? James tried to fill internally because there weren't any supply teachers available. The board has been overwhelmed because of the number of teachers doing virtual learning but they have now hired more supply teachers.
- Was it okay to send siblings of the class exposed to a positive case back to school? Yes. Public Health determines which students need to stay home and, in this case, siblings were able to go to school. Public Health deals with this on a case by case basis.
- **Is there a need to do fundraising?** Not at this point. Needs have changed due to how things are being used. Fundraising presents challenges (e.g. how to store/distribute poinsettias). Some money has been spent on sport equipment. There will be some junior classes going to the outdoor campus in December (no volunteers).
- Is there a way to offer breakfast club items to students who need it? Niagara Nutrition partners will provide the funding. James will revisit the guidelines to figure out if we can offer prepackaged snacks in a bin.
